WHAT IS INSTITUTE OF ADVANCED STUDIES

IAS was formed in 1987 to pursue practical, accessible quality enhancements to the educational resources available in the traditional health care professions higher educational system. The structure to carry out this objective brought setting up IAS as a Non-profit charitable corporation in the state of California with an Exempt organizational status from the IRS as a 501 (c) (3) corporation.

Seminars and workshops were designed in the health care field and given with Orange County as a base of operations to professionals and those interested in the topics or in training for professional careers in the field. Presenters are chosen for their knowledge and experience in the topic being covered. These included Marriage and Family therapists, Psychologists, Physicians or other professionals with

COUNSELING

COMMUNITY SERVICES

Counseling Service is provided at Neighborhood Centers, Shelters, School, Church and office locations offering convenient accessibility in Orange and neighboring Counties.

MENTORING

Pre-licensed counselors are supervised with the professional development model using mentoring as a prime factor in the professional maturation process.

AFFORDABILITY

Providing services to the community as a sliding scale, low fee alternative to higher cost forms of counseling and related services with Children and Adults as Individuals, Couples, Families or Groups.

ACCESSIBILITY

The locations are predominantly in community or faith based organizations and shelters interested in hosting the program. Many times Organizations are more comfortable in having a third party handle the counseling.
